# Bylaws Changes Recommended for Approval at the February 23, 2012 Annual Meeting of the General Membership

At its December 15, 2011 Board meeting, the Directors recommended changes to the current Bylaws. The changes will be placed before the General Membership for approval at the General Membership Meeting on February 23, 2012 at 5:30 p.m. at the Hawai'i State Library. The substantive highlights of those recommended changes are as follows:

Article IV, Officers and Directors

Delete Board term limits and "provide that Directors who fail to attend two consecutive Board meetings without excuse or who have otherwise demonstrated no interest in the welfare of the Corporation shall be removed by the Nominating Committee."

Article V, Executive Director

Change the provision that the Board of Directors, not the Executive Committee, shall appoint the Executive Director.

Article VIII, Board of Directors

Change the meeting quorum from a majority of the directors 10 to 40% or 8 directors

Article IX, Committees and Subcommittee

Reorganize and create the Board Committees to make it less cumbersome and in keeping with actual practice.

Article XIII, Policies and Procedures

Provide that contracts may be signed by any two officers of the Corporation rather than only the President or Vice President and the Treasurer in the event that the President, Vice President or the Treasurer are unavailable.

Other non-substantive changes were made to Articles VI and VII.

The Board of Directors thank you in advance for taking the time to consider their recommended changes to the Bylaws.
